Description: Developed for those serving as the senior information technology executive of a

nonprofit organization, this course covers a wide variety of topics that are critical to the

success of a CIO. Specific topics include:

- CIO Roles
- Leadership
- Communication
- Technology Governance
- Budget and Finance
- Strategic Planning and Metrics
- Policy Development and Ethics
- Career Planning

Each topic is explored in-depth through presentations, case study, discussion, group work, and assignments. The class concludes with a series of advising sessions with higher education CIOs affiliated with our program.

Outcomes: Upon completion of this course, students should be able to:

- Classify the roles of the CIO
- Analyze leadership as it applies to the CIO and IT department
- Evaluate organization dynamics and implement/adjust the governance model
- Describe the characteristics of IT department financial and budgeting models
- Compare strategic planning processes and models
- Identify policy development and ethics challenges in IT departments
- Describe successful CIO-Executive and CIO-Board interactions and relationships
- Initiate a CIO career plan
