Description: Designed for technology professionals who are considering their readiness for a Chief Information Officer (CIO) position, this course covers a wide variety of topics that are critical for success. Specific topics include:

Each topic is explored in-depth through presentations, case study, discussion, group work, and assignments. The class concludes with a series of advising sessions with CIOs affiliated with our program.

- Compare and contrast major information resources for the CIO
- Describe the major security and compliance issues in IT
- Describe the major ethics issues facing the CIO
- Explain how an organization's culture impacts IT governance and services
- Develop a career plan and assess individual readiness for a CIO position
