**REMAINING REQUIREMENTS TO COMPLETE THE EXCELSIOR COLLEGE B.S. IN NURSING\***

This degree requires the completion of 121 credits in semester hours. Listed below are the remaining requirements. Lower level credits may be completed with additional community college coursework. Courses/exams offered at Excelsior College are denoted in bold.

**INFORMATION LITERACY REQUIREMENT**

1.00 credit in Information Literacy

**INL\*102 INFORMATION LITERACY** or an approved alternative

**HUMANITIES DISTRIBUTION**

6.00 credits in humanities to include:

- 3.00 credits Intermediate or Advance Expository Writing Core

The expository writing course must build upon introductory composition courses and further develop skills in expository writing. Typically, a second semester English composition or freshman writing course would be the prerequisite for an intermediate or advanced expository writing course. The course at a minimum needs to be at the sophomore level.

6.00 credits Social Sciences

**NATURAL SCIENCE/MATH DISTRIBUTION**

3.00 credits in Statistics (*St Vincent's: MATH\*212 Elem Statistics*)

**ARTS & SCIENCES ELECTIVES**

9.00 credits in the arts and sciences

**Note:** At least three of these credits should be completed at the upper level to fulfill the upper level requirement needed for the depth. Excelsior suggests an upper course/exam in psychology to combine with the two psychology courses already completed as part of this program.

### **DEPTH REQUIREMENT**

A depth consists of 9 credits in one arts & sciences academic discipline, of which 3 hours must be upper level. An average grade of "C" is required in this area. These credits are typically part of and not necessarily in addition to the credits listed above.
